



General Rules

Your Dogs

- You should be in control of your dogs at all time and when outside of the private hire area. Only allow your dog off the lead once you are in the field and the gate has been secured behind you
- We offer a safe area for dogs – out of control dogs will not be accepted
- All dogs must be accompanied by an adult (aged 18+)
- They must be up to date with their vaccinations
- If your dog shows any signs of ill health you must cancel your session
- Do not enter the field until the previous attendee has securely left the field with their dog
- We recommend you have insurance & public liability cover for your dog(s).
- Attendees are responsible for their dog(s) at all times. We take no responsibility for your dog's whilst they are using the field
- Dogs must not be left unattended at any time
- It is the user's responsibility to ensure the gate is locked when using the park. Users must check that the park is suitable for their dog(s) use prior to entering
- Clean up after your dog immediately & place poo bags in the bin provided.
- No littering
- Please do not climb on the fencing or agility equipment. This is intended for dog use only
- Any breakages or damage to the park will be paid for by the dog owner
- Dogs should have a collar or harness with a clear ID tag
- We can accept a maximum of 6 dogs on the field in any one slot

Booking and Time Keeping

- The park is only available on a pre-booking basis
- Please ensure that you vacate your private hire area on time to avoid disrupting any future bookings for other visitors
- All sessions must be booked before you arrive
- Sessions are for 55 min time slots
- Please allow 5 minutes at the end of your session to leave, making sure it is vacant for the next person
- Any additional sessions due to overrunning the time slot, must be paid for
- If you arrive late, you cannot extend your booking

Payments, Cancellations & Re-Scheduling

- Payment for hire of the park is due prior to arrival
- Any bookings cancelled or rescheduled within 24 hours cannot be refunded

Gates and Attending the Park

- Keep the gate shut at all times
 - All gates must be kept closed at all times
 - Keep your dog(s) on a lead in the car park. They can only be unleash once in the field

Leads

- If you are outside of your private hire enclosure, your dog should be under control and on a lead at all times
- Even if your dog has perfect recall, this is requested to protect other user of the facility

Aggressive Dogs

- If your dog is aggressive, please ensure that you keep your distance from other dogs whilst traveling to and from your enclosed private space. If you require assistance, please ask

Clean Up

- If your dog fouls, then please pick it up and use one of our dedicated bins to dispose of the waste
- Please also bin any rubbish you may have during your visit. Please leave the site as you found it

- Most importantly of all, have fun and let your dog's enjoy themselves in our safe and secure Bowdon Dog Park!
